Summary of Benefits

This booklet gives you a summary of what we cover and what you pay. It does not list every service that we cover or list every limitation or exclusion. To get a complete list of services we cover, call us and ask for the “Evidence of Coverage.”

Note*: The AllCare Special Needs Plan, Redwood Rx is an HMO D-SNP plan designed for people who have both Medicare (Parts: A, B, and D) and full Oregon Health Plan (OHP) (Medicaid) benefits. If you see an asterisk (*) it means the cost-sharing amount does not apply to you.

You have choices about how to get your Medicare benefits.

- One choice is to get your Medicare benefits through Original Medicare (fee-for-service Medicare). Original Medicare is run directly by the federal government.
- Another choice is to get your Medicare benefits by joining a Medicare health plan, such as **AllCare Advantage Redwood Rx**.

Things to Know About AllCare Advantage Redwood Rx

Hours of Operation.

Who can join?

To join AllCare Advantage, you must be entitled to Medicare Part A, be enrolled in Medicare Part B, have full Oregon Health Plan (OHP) (Medicaid) benefits, and live in our service area. Our service area includes the following counties: Curry, Jackson, Josephine, and Glendale and Azalea in Douglas County.

Which doctors, hospitals, and pharmacies can I use?

AllCare Advantage Redwood Rx has a network of doctors, hospitals, pharmacies, and other providers. Except in emergency situations, if you use the providers that are not in our network, we may not pay for these services.

You must generally use network pharmacies to fill your prescriptions for covered Part D drugs.

What do we cover?

Like all Medicare health plans, we cover everything that Original Medicare covers—and more.

- Our plan members get all of the benefits covered by Original Medicare.
- Our members also get more than what is covered by Original Medicare.

Redwood Rx includes prescription drug coverage.

How will I determine my drug costs?

During the Initial Coverage Stage:

Drug Tier 1: You pay 25% coinsurance.

If you qualify for Low Income Subsidy (LIS), you will receive a separate LIS Rider that will explain what you will pay.

Catastrophic Coverage Stage:

During this payment stage, you pay nothing for your covered Part D drugs.

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How Much You Pay for Covered Services

Monthly Plan Premium	Redwood Rx: \$0 per month. You must continue to pay your Medicare Part B premium.*
Deductible	\$0 deductible.
Maximum Out-of-Pocket Responsibility <i>(does not include prescription drugs)</i>	You pay no more than \$9,250 annually.*

**Your full Oregon Health Plan (OHP) (Medicaid) benefit pays this amount for you.*

Inpatient and Outpatient Care

Inpatient Hospital Care ¹	You pay \$0 cost for Inpatient Hospital Care. (Limited stay; same as Original Medicare).
Outpatient Hospital Services ¹	You pay \$0 cost for Outpatient Hospital Services.
Ambulatory Surgical Center (ASC) Services ¹	You pay \$0 cost for Ambulatory Surgical Center (ASC) Services.
Doctor Visits • Primary • Specialists	You pay \$0 cost for Primary Care Providers and Specialists.
Preventive Care <i>(e.g., flu vaccine, diabetic screenings)</i>	You pay \$0 cost for Preventive Care.

Emergency Care	You pay \$0 cost for Emergency Care.
Urgently Needed Services	You pay \$0 cost for Urgently Needed Services.
Diagnostic tests and therapeutic services¹	You pay \$0 cost for Diagnostic Services/Labs/Imaging (including diagnostic tests and procedures, labs, diagnostic radiology, and X-rays).
Hearing Services • Medicare-covered hearing services	You pay \$0 cost for Hearing Services.
Dental Services • Medicare-covered dental services	You pay \$0 cost for Dental Services.
Vision Services • Medicare-covered eye exam • Eyewear allowance	You pay \$0 cost for Vision Services. Eyewear allowance \$460 every year.
Mental Health Services • Outpatient group therapy/individual therapy visit	You pay \$0 cost for Mental Health Services
Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF)¹	You pay \$0 cost for Skilled Nursing Facility. Our plan covers up to 100 days in a SNF. You may be admitted to a SNF without prior hospital stay.

Physical Therapy¹ <i>(Medicare-covered physical, occupational, speech therapy, cardiac (heart) and pulmonary rehabilitation services)</i>	You pay \$0 cost for Physical Therapy.
Ambulance	You pay \$0 cost for Ambulance. Medically necessary ground and air ambulance is covered anywhere in the United States, including from one hospital to another hospital providing a higher level of care or to a skilled nursing facility. Non-emergent ambulance transportation requires prior authorization (PA).
Transportation (Non-emergent)	Is not covered.
Medicare Part B Drugs¹	You pay \$0 cost for Medicare-covered Part B drugs.
Chiropractic Services (Medicare-covered)	You pay \$0 cost for Chiropractic Services. Manipulation of the spine to correct subluxation <i>(when one or more of the bones of your spine move out of position)</i>.
Counseling Support Services	You pay \$0 cost for Counseling Support Services. The counseling support services benefit includes: Counseling on family and other relationship issues, grief issues, and life changes. • No referral required • You must use plan providers • You have unlimited visits For more information on Medicare-covered Mental Health benefits, see section “Outpatient Mental Health Care” in the Evidence of Coverage.

Diabetes Supplies and Services	You pay \$0 cost for Continuous Glucose Monitors (CGM) or diabetes monitoring supplies. For diabetic related durable medical equipment, such as an External Insulin Pump, please refer to the section “Durable Medical Equipment and Related Supplies” in your Evidence of Coverage.
Durable Medical Equipment (DME)¹	You pay \$0 cost for Durable Medical Equipment (DME).
Fall Prevention¹	You pay \$0 cost for an in-home safety assessment and for bathroom safety devices.
Health and Wellness Education Programs	You pay \$0 cost for the following: • General health care management and other wellness services • Health education classes • Nutritional training • Tobacco cessation • 24-hour Nurse Help Line
Home Healthcare¹	You pay \$0 cost for Home Healthcare.
Meal Benefit¹	You pay \$0 cost for Meal Benefit. This benefit is unlimited; 30 meals in 30 days after each hospital (inpatient) or skilled nursing facility (SNF) discharge.
Prosthetic Devices¹	You pay \$0 cost for Prosthetic Devices.
Renal Dialysis	You pay \$0 cost for Renal Dialysis.

Outpatient Prescription Drugs

You may get up to a 100-day supply on most prescription drugs.

During the Initial Coverage Stage:

Drug Tier 1: You pay 25% coinsurance

If you qualify for Low Income Subsidy (LIS), you will receive a separate LIS Rider that will explain what you will pay.

Catastrophic Coverage Stage:

During this payment stage, you pay nothing for your covered Part D drugs.

Important Message about What You Pay for Vaccines – Our plan covers most Part D vaccines at no cost to you, even if you haven't paid your deductible. Call Customer Care for more information.

Important Message about What You Pay for Insulin – You won't pay more than \$35 for a one-month supply of each insulin product covered by our plan, no matter what cost-sharing tier it's on, even if you haven't paid your deductible.
